

Colors

Colors on a web page are combinations of red, green, and blue light. Each pixel has red, green and blue light that make up the color.

The `rgb` function is used to tell the browser what combination of red, green, and blue light to use. Each value may be a number between 0 and 255. 0 means none of that color, 255 means use all of that color.

Example: `rgb(255,0,0)` is full red, no green, no blue.

There is also a hexadecimal notation. It is a 6-digit number preceded by a pound sign (#). 2 digits are used to convert each decimal rgb value to a hexadecimal number.

Example: `rgb(0,250,0)` is `#00FA00`

Example: `rgb(250,180,72)` is `#FAB448`

Example: `rgb(0,10,60)` is `#000A3C`

Example: `#F45A6C` is `rgb(244,90,108)`

Example: `#FA0C80` is `rgb(250, 12, 128)`

Example: `#800080` is `rgb(128,0,128)`

In addition, there are 16 color reserved words:

CSS and Colors

There are 2 basic CSS properties for color: `color` is used to specify the font-color. `background-color` is used for a page color. The following CSS sets the default page color to aqua and the default text color to white:

```
body {  
    background-color: #00FFFF;  
    color: #FFFFFF;  
}
```
