Course Description

In *Lego Robotics*, students design, program, and construct robots to accomplish specific tasks. Students learn and use basic programming techniques using the Robot Educator.

All assignments in the course will be done with a partner. Your grade is based on a combination of the grade your robot received and your daily participation points for the assignment. If you are absent, you will receive zero daily participation points and it will affect your grade if your partner is able to continue with the work to be done.

Required Materials

- Flash drive (provided)
- Pencil / Eraser

Late Work and Do Overs

Assignments will be graded when completed, but no options to do them over are available. There are final dates after which no assignments may be turned in. Do your best to work with your partner to get your work done on time.

Subject Grading

Each assignment will be worth different point amounts depending on the skills needed to complete the assignment and the length of time the assignment is expected to take.

Cooperation Grading

Cooperation grades are earned by accumulating points. You have the potential to receive 5 cooperation points each day class meets. You will either receive all 5 points for the day, or no points for the day.

You will receive zero points for any of the following reasons:

- Student is tardy to class without an excused tardy pass
- Student is absent from class
- Student is talking excessively or out of seat
- Student refuses to put away an electronic device when asked
- Student is doing work for another teacher
- Student is using a classroom computer inappropriately
- Student is eating

Grading Scale
